
# Magnetic Cable Channel

**WARNING:** Disconnect all power before installing or adjusting the Cable Channel. Secure all cords and check that the channel is firmly attached before reconnecting power.

**WARNING:** This product is made from plastic and may deform if exposed to excessive heat or flame. Keep away from heat sources and open flames.

**WARNING:** Periodically check for signs of wear, cracking, or loosening of the Cable Channel or cables. Replace immediately if any damage is found.

#### Assembly Instructions

### Step 1 - Cable Routing


Route cables through the inside of the Cable Channel.

## Step 2 - Cable Channel Placement

Place the Cable Channel along any steel surface long enough to accommodate the full length of the channel.

If placing it on a height adjustable desk leg, ensure that it is positioned on the outermost & widest telescoping leg section and that cables have sufficient slack to accommodate the desk's full range of movement.

Do NOT place the Cable Channel anywhere between a moving part of the desk and a stationary object.
